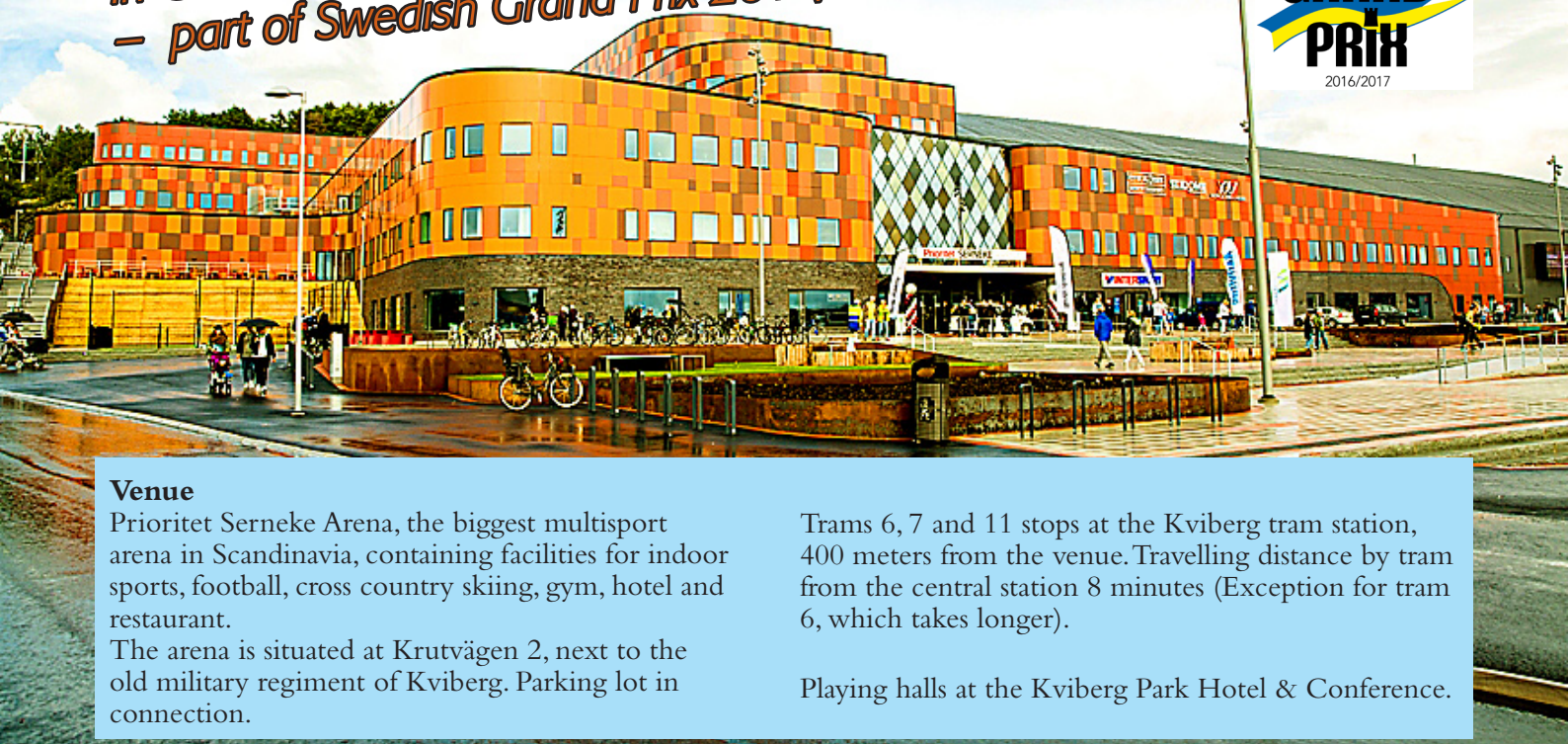


SS Manhem invites you to Kvibergspelen

in Göteborg from May 5 to 7 2017
– part of Swedish Grand Prix 2016/2017



Venue

Prioritet Serneke Arena, the biggest multisport arena in Scandinavia, containing facilities for indoor sports, football, cross country skiing, gym, hotel and restaurant.

The arena is situated at Krutvägen 2, next to the old military regiment of Kviberg. Parking lot in connection.

Trams 6, 7 and 11 stops at the Kviberg tram station, 400 meters from the venue. Travelling distance by tram from the central station 8 minutes (Exception for tram 6, which takes longer).

Playing halls at the Kviberg Park Hotel & Conference.

Tournament System

8 rounds Fide Swiss. The tournament is registered to FIDE for Elo calculation.

Round 1 – 4: 15 minutes + 5 sec per move

Round 5 – 8: 90 minutes + 30 sec per move

Prizes

Main prizes: **1:** 12000 SEK. **2:** 6000 SEK. **3:** 4000 SEK. **4:** 2000 SEK. **5:** 999 SEK. **6:** 999 SEK. **7:** 999 SEK. The final prize list will be decided using Tie Break Points. Main prizes will be shared according to the Hort System between 1st and 12th place.

Rating prizes: **1:** 800 SEK **2:** 600 SEK in groups of 12 players. Special prizes for best female player, best youth U20, U16 and U12, best senior (+65) 600 SEK.

Preliminary taxes will be deducted according to Swedish tax legislation.

Entry fee

The entry fee is 600 SEK. For payments before April 21st at the latest, we offer a discount of 100 SEK. GM, WGM, IM och WIM, entered before April 21st may participate free of entry fee. We have a limited number of hotel rooms for grandmasters – get in touch at the soonest! The entry fee should be paid to SS Manhem's postal giro account pg 42 28 22 – 7. Payment of entry fee at the playing site will be charged with an extra fee of 100 SEK (does not apply to foreign players). Players marked with "paid" at the website may arrive to the first round without having to sign up.

"Little Kvibergspelen"

Parallel to the Kvibergspelen, we also organize the "Little Kvibergspelen", open to players rated below 1600 in Elo. For players without Elo, latest national Swedish rating will apply.

Entry fee: 500 SEK. For payments before April 21st at the latest, we offer a discount of 100 SEK. Payment of entry fee at the playing site will be charged with an extra fee of 100 SEK (does not apply to foreign players).

Other data on tournament system, time schedule and entries are equivalent to those for the main tournament.

Main prizes: **1:** 2500 SEK, **2:** 1500 SEK, **3:** 999 SEK, **4:** 999 SEK. Rating prizes: **1:** 700 SEK, **2:** 500 SEK in groups of 12 players. Only Elo rated players can qualify for a rating prize.
